Volunteer with us!

Almost all Crossroads' staff are volunteers, including our full-time team, serving both locally and internationally. We simply couldn't do the work we do without our volunteers!

We welcome groups to visit and help out in various activities around our site. If anyone has physical concerns it is helpful to know of these prior to the event, and we will always do our best on the day to place group members appropriately.

To ensure that everyone has a meaningful and productive day, our suggested group size for a "general volunteering" type of service is 25-30max (there is no minimum) and we are able to tailor activities for larger groups. We may need to split large groups into smaller groups and allocate tasks accordingly.

Although volunteering is generally free, you are welcome to give an optional donation towards the operational costs of your day with us.

School groups

We encourage schools to bring a ratio of one teacher/ assistant per eight students for supervision. We usually have only one manager operating in each department and they will require help to supervise the students. Our age guideline for group volunteering is 14 years and above.

We have more than 10 different departments dealing with goods donations here at Crossroads. Some of the tasks involved include:

- Sorting and packing donated goods: This is the main task in our processing departments (e.g. toys, household goods, clothing, and book departments).
 Groups can also run collection drives for wanted goods.
- Renovations: Includes activities such as painting, gardening, landscaping and maintenance.
- Heavy work: The work involved in our shipping and furniture departments can often include heavy work (e.g. preparing furniture for shipments, loading containers, and unloading trucks).

Please note: We take pictures for all our container loadings for publication and feedback to sponsors. Notify us if you do not want your pictures taken when participating in loading a container.

Practical Information

- Lunch: The Gold Coast Shopping Mall is located across the street, and offers a wide selection of restaurants, including McDonalds and Chinese restaurants. You can also book one of our rooms ahead of time and order your own lunch.
- What to bring? Please do make sure each participant is wearing closed toe shoes and appropriate outdoor clothing to respect the various cultures represented on site. Please note: no short shorts/miniskirts or spaghetti straps)

Additionally, each participant should make arrangements for:

- Mosquito repellent
- Sun/Rain protection, as needed
- Personal water bottle, which can be refilled at various stations around the site
- Some money for purchasing products in the Fair Trade Café and Shop (optional)
- Wet Weather Plan: We encourage volunteers to bring wet weather gear if rain is forecast, but unless advised otherwise, you will be based indoors if weather is wet.
- **Typhoon Policy:** Crossroads remains open during T1 and T3 Typhoon signals. When it is likely that a T8 or above signal will be hoisted, we will close, and advise volunteers to head home. Additionally, we remain open during an Amber and Red Rainstorm, but close when a Black Rainstorm signal is hoisted.

Dubai Ports World (DP World), as its name suggests, knows almost everything there is to know about getting goods from A to B. One of our partners in Zambia received a massive capital injection of goods for their education project, including a large quantity of school provision that raised the bar in their community school to the point where they now qualify to be an examination centre for the region (pictured right).

Crossroads ran a campaign to source electrical goods and other needed support. The response was immediate and overwhelming! Several businesses and individuals leaped to help, offering to fund or supply what we needed. When our team went out to Tai O to help, offering to fund or supply what recognised our red Crossroads t-shirts calling out, deliver and install the goods, residents recognised our red Crossroads the small lanes. "Thank you, thank you!" as our volunteers pushed heavy appliances along the small lanes.

Mrs Kan herself was pleased to see her washing machine and fridge replaced. Mr Kwan, and other neighbours also received electrical goods and our staff helped install and connect them (pictured right).

As well as Tai O, we were also pleased to support Kar Wo Lei Tsuen, a village right next door to Crossroads' site, where people suffered storm damage to homes and possessions.



Your service changes lives!

CORPORATE DONATION COMPUTER CLASSES FOR INDIA'S POOR

At 22, Musharif should have been excited about a life ahead of him, but he felt he was going nowhere. His family had tried to survive on his father's minimal salary as a rickshaw driver. They lived in a poor part of Pune, India, where Musharif dropped out of school early and started earning a minimal income in a mechanic's workshop.

While Musharif was feeling trapped in Pune, an investment company, in a nearby part of India, had 27 computers to get rid of, some of them very high-end. They reached out to Crossroads' Global Hand, an we helped match them to an NGO which serves the poor in India. They used these computers to help set up a computer school that now offers high quality training at very low cost. Musharif's friend told him of the course. He enrolled and did so well that he was offered a job in a tech company, became a team leader, received a pay rise whithin four months. "I sincerely believe that the IT school has changed my life completely," he says.

We love Musharif's story: one small opportunity, driven by one company's decision not to trash their computers, can be the key to breaking the poverty cycle for a grassroots



GOODS DONATION KAZAKHSTAN: DISABILITY

"This is the only English centre programme in our city where people with disabilities can study English," said our partners in Shymkent, Kazakhstan. We shipped furniture and other goods to help equip this centre which gives young people from grassroots families, and those with disabilities, access to English language lessons in an exceptionally supportive, caring environment.



SPONSORSHIP & VOLUNTEERING HELP FOR ORPHANS IN MOLDOVA

We love to be a voice for people in hardship that rarely get global attention, such as Moldova's orphanages.

Meeting their many needs is costly and hard working NGO do their best to give shelter, food, medicine and education along with emotional suppor 'Extras', such as toys, can be harder. We were blown away, then, when toy company Hasbro offered us an entire shipping container filled with toys. We were the more so when they sent 8 of their own staff to help load it. And off it went to Moldoya!
